**TEMPORARY ORDER ON

The above-named Petitioner having filed a petition by Order to Show Cause on May 2, 2025 seeking to modify an order dated June 13, 2018, granting custody and visitation made by the Family Court of the State of New York, Westchester County, Docket Nos. V-8186/7/8/9-14/15B, V-8186/7/8/9-14/17P, as modified by an order dated July 19, 2022, terminating visitation, made by the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of Westchester, File No. 966.

And the Respondent Marc Fishman having filed a petition by Order to Show Cause on May 7, 2025 seeking to modify custody and having filed Opposition to Petitioner's Order to Show Cause on May 19, 2025;

And the Petitioner having appeared personally and with counsel Virginia Foulkrod, Esq. and the Respondent having appeared virtually without counsel;

And the Court having searched the statewide registry of orders of protection, the sex offender registry and the Family Court's warrant and child protective records, and having notified the parties of any results of these searches;

The Respondent Marc Fishman shall have no access to school records, school staff, online portals and any other providers associated with Aidan Fishman DOB 7/14/2008 and Skye Fishman DOB 7/14/2008; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order shall expire upon issuance of a further or final order in this case.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Decision and Order After Fact Finding, entered by this Court on June 13, 2018 and modified by Decision and Order of the Supreme Court entered on July 19, 2022, shall continue in full force and effect, as amended by this Temporary Order.
